

What size nut should a 20mm cable tray be

For a 20mm cable tray bolt, an M6 or M8 nut is typically used, with M6 being the most common for standard 20mm tray bolts.

Recommended Nut Size

For a 20mm cable tray bolt, the standard nut size is usually M6 when paired with a 20mm length bolt. These nuts are often serrated flange nuts, which provide a vibration-resistant hold and prevent loosening over time. The flange design increases friction and distributes pressure evenly, making it ideal for electrical and mechanical installations. In some cases, M8 nuts may be used if the tray or installation requires a heavier-duty connection, but for most standard 20mm cable tray bolts, M6 nuts are sufficient.

Types of Nuts

- Flange Nuts: Commonly used with 20mm tray bolts; serrated to resist vibration.
- Tray Nuts: Designed specifically for cable trays, providing secure attachment to the tray slots.

Installation Tips

- Ensure the nut matches the bolt thread (e.g., M6 bolt with M6 nut).
- Use a pozidrive or Phillips screwdriver for truss head bolts to tighten efficiently.
