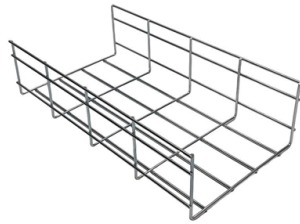

Cable Sizing Rule: For 20A circuits, use 12-gauge wire minimum. Tool Tip: Use calculators to check voltage ΔV over distances. A 100-foot run needs thicker wire than a 20-foot run for the same appliance! When to Call a Pro. Your circuit count leads directly to the box size. The distribution box is just one piece. The NEC provides two distinct methods for sizing junction boxes, depending on wire size: NEC 314. 16 (Box Fill): For smaller conductors (6 AWG and smaller), sizing is based on total volume required. Think of it as “The Fill Factor” —every component inside that box gets a vote, and you need to count. Choosing the right wire size is critical for electrical safety and code compliance.
