When to Use a Splice Tray

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During Fiber Splicing: Whenever fibers are joined, either by fusion splicing (using heat to fuse fibers) or mechanical splicing (using alignment devices), a splice tray is used to secure the splice and protect it from damage .

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In Fiber Enclosures or Closures: Splice trays are deployed inside fiber distribution boxes, splicing closures, or rack-mount enclosures to organize multiple splices and maintain a clean network layout .
