

Where should I plug the fiber optic cable into the router

Fiber optic cables usually plug into an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which then connects to your router via the WAN/Ethernet port, unless your router has a dedicated fiber input.

Step-by-Step Connection

1. Identify the fiber entry point: The fiber optic line from your ISP enters your home through a wall outlet. This is where the fiber cable begins its path to your network . 2. Connect to the ONT: Most home setups require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), provided by your ISP. The fiber cable plugs into the ONT's optical port, which converts the light signal into an electrical signal your router can use . Handle the fiber connector carefully, avoiding dirt or bending the cable sharply. 3. Link the ONT to the router: Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port. This port is often labeled "Internet" or "WAN" and may be colored differently from LAN ports . 4. Power on devices: First, plug in and power on the ONT. Wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network. Then, power on your router and wait for its indicator lights to confirm connectivity . 5. Optional direct fiber-ready routers: Some routers have a dedicated SFP or PON port for direct fiber input. In this case, the fiber cable can plug directly into the router, bypassing the ONT. Ensure your router supports this type of connection before attempting . 6. Verify the connection: Check your devices for internet access and, if needed, log into the router's admin panel to enter ISP credentials or update firmware for optimal performance .
