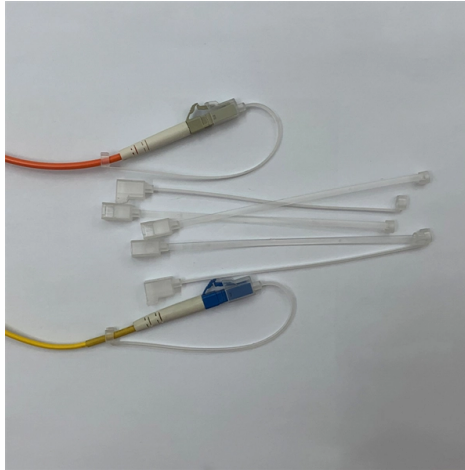


Wiring and installation diagram of photovoltaic combiner box

A PV combiner box wiring diagram shows how multiple solar panel strings are combined in parallel, protected by fuses or breakers, connected to busbars, grounded, and routed to the inverter with surge protection.

Core Components and Wiring Path

A typical DC PV combiner box includes the following components:

- **String Fuses or DC Breakers:** Protect individual PV strings from overcurrent and short circuits. Each positive conductor from a PV string passes through a fuse or breaker before reaching the busbar .
- **Positive and Negative Busbars:** Collect current from all strings. Positive busbars connect to the DC isolator or output breaker, while negative busbars connect directly to the inverter's negative input .
- **DC Isolator / Output Breaker:** Provides a disconnect point for maintenance and safety, allowing the combined DC output to be safely routed to the inverter .
- **Surge Protection Devices (SPDs):** Protect the system from transient overvoltages caused by lightning or switching events. SPDs are connected across DC conductors and grounded to the protective earth .
- **Grounding Bar:** All metallic parts, PV module frames, and SPD earth terminals are connected to a common grounding bar, which is then connected to the site grounding system .
