Core Functions

A fiber optic terminal junction box is primarily used to terminate incoming fiber optic cables, manage splices, and distribute optical signals to outgoing drop cables or patch cords, acting as the interface between feeder fibers and end-user connections in FTTH, FTTB, or other access networks . It ensures stable signal transmission, facilitates testing and maintenance, and provides mechanical and environmental protection for delicate fiber components .

Key Components

- **Housing/Enclosure:** Made from durable materials like ABS, PC, or metal, the enclosure protects fibers from dust, moisture, and physical damage. Outdoor models are often watertight and UV-resistant .
- **Splice Trays:** Organize and protect fusion or mechanical splices, preventing stress or bending of fibers .
- **Adapter Plates/Ports:** Support SC, LC, FC, or ST connectors for plug-and-play connections to drop cables .
- **Fiber Storage:** Provides slack management to neatly store excess fiber length .
